Terms and Conditions

This is an informal Bike Show, The intention is to make the classification of the bikes in the various categories, and the judging of the Show, as straightforward and fair as possible.

- All bikes to be entered in the Show can be registered, by completing a Bike Show entry form (which will be retained by the judges).
- All bikes must have a TITG bike parking band and their owners must be rally ticket holders.
- Bikes may be trailered to the event but must be fully functional and ridden to the location of the bike show.
- All motorcycles and trikes must be covered by a current insurance policy with appropriate cover and all riders must be fully competent and have an appropriate licence.
- Once the competition is finished all bikes must be removed from the show area.
- Entry forms will be available from the Dunedin Chapter Tent during opening times or downloaded from the Dunedin Chapter Website. Applications should be returned to the Dunedin Chapter Tent.
- The show takes place from 4.00 pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 23rd August, 2025. Bikes MUST be parked in the show area before 4.00 pm and not removed until after judging. Bikes must not be moved during this time so that it is a safe area for visitors to walk around. In exceptional circumstances a bike may be moved with the assistance of a marshal. No bikes are to be left running unattended and must be of a safe working condition.
- All entrants must obey the organisers instructions and not endanger any pedestrians or others on the site.
- Judging will take place at 5.00pm. Each category winner will be awarded a small prize and the bike will be photographed and posted on our social media accounts.
- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the competition, according to the opinion of the Judges whose decision is final.
- Any questions regarding conditions of entry and competition processes should be directed to the organisers of the rally, Dunedin Chapter Scotland.
- Dunedin Chapter Scotland does not accept any responsibility for any damage, loss of bike or personal effects or liability incurred at the Bike Show and rally.
