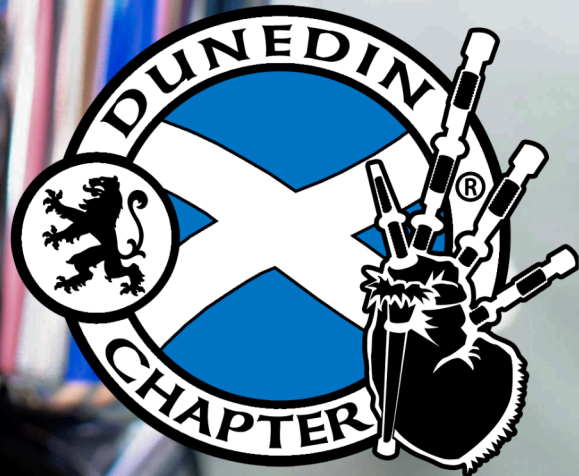

The upshot to the HOG community is that over the next few years you will see the return of a much broader product range which will be aimed at increasing the appeal and reach of the brand. From a dealership perspective, it's very welcomed and a sign that there is a significant change of direction with the appointment of their new CEO Artie Starrs.

Becky and I are off to Prague early May where H-D will be showing us and taking orders for some of their new seasonal apparel and I've been told to expect to see something very new there too – exciting!

I began motorbiking when I turned 17, but after experiencing two major accidents, I decided against risking a third incident. Consequently, I didn't get back into riding until I was 50 years old. I started with a Keeway Superlight 125, which had about as much power as a gentle breeze against a sieve, and I successfully completed my motorcycle test in February 2020.

Initially, after passing my exam, I intended to buy a Kawasaki Vulcan and avoid joining any club. However, a friend advised me against this, suggesting that I would ultimately end up with a Harley, so I should just go for one right away. While I was assisting in setting up for the 2020 Scottish Motorbike Show, I met a few members and decided to join the chapter in March.

After riding a Black Harley Sportster 1200XL Super Low for six months, I realised it wasn't suitable for two riders, leading me to upgrade my bike. I then purchased a Road King, but after a few close calls with dropping it, I opted for a Harley Ultra Low, which is better for shorter riders. Following that, I traded it in for a quite 2021 Sport Glide. By June 2025, I upgraded to an Alpine Green 2024 Road Glide that had just over 2000 miles on it, complete with a comfortable upgraded seat, chrome footpegs, and Jekyll and Hyde exhausts. So far, I've added Kahuna Heated Grips.





February

We started off the year with our first trip to the theatre to see the Queen musical *We Will Rock You*, preceded by a lovely pre theatre dinner at Dhoom in Dunfermline. Both the food and the show were excellent.

Next up we had our second trip into Edinburgh for Club Tropicana, and a bit of afternoon clubbing. I've a feeling we may return later in the year for one of their country events.

March

The Chapter annual trip to The Scottish Motorcycle show in Edinburgh did not disappoint, we had a very busy stand, with two of our ladies showing their beautiful bikes.

Upcoming Events at time of writing:

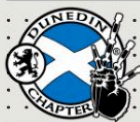
International female ride day is coming up on 2nd May. LOH from UK Chapters have arranged ride outs in celebration. We did

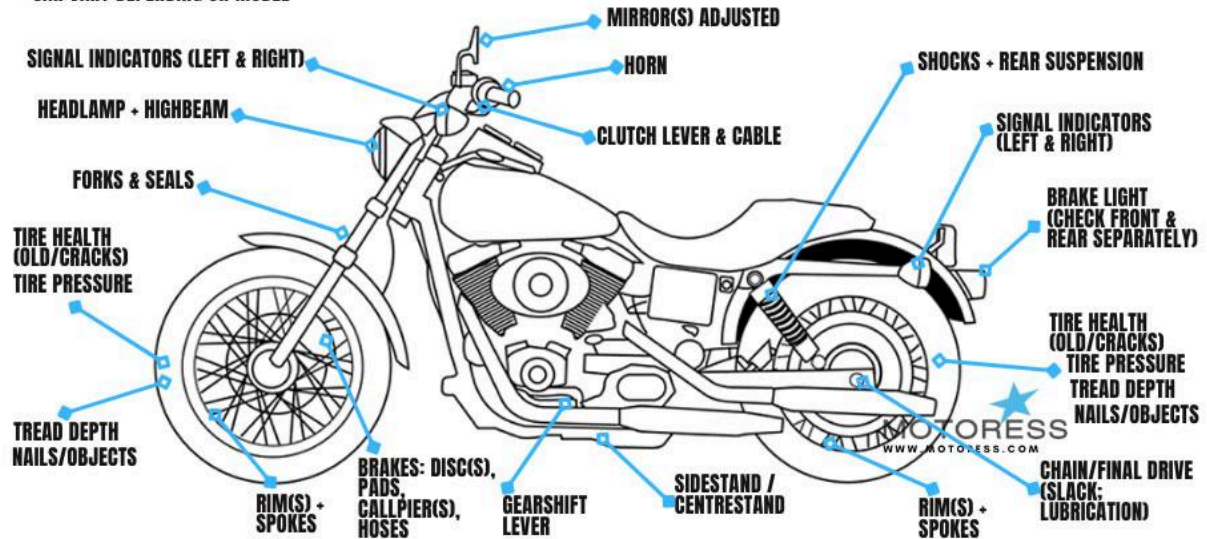

Bikes, Gear & Getting Road Ready

Spring's here. The roads are calling, the bikes are waking up, and somewhere out there... someone's already broken down because they skipped the basics. Don't be that story.

This is your quick, no nonsense guide to getting yourself, and your Harley, ready to ride.

The 10 Minute Bike Check (Do It. Seriously.)

You don't need to be a mechanic, just mildly responsible.

Tyres

Check pressure (not "kick it and hope")

Look for cracks, flat spots, or anything that says "I've been sitting since October"

Brakes

Pads still there? Good start.

Any squealing, grinding, or "that doesn't feel right"? Get it looked at brakes aren't a gamble

Battery

If it sounds like it's struggling, it is struggling

If you didn't trickle charge it over winter... well, you're about to find out why people do

Fluids

Oil, brake fluid, coolant (if applicable)

If it's low, top it up. If it's black and mysterious, change it

Lights & Indicators

Quick walk around check

If your indicator's flashing like it's having a nervous breakdown, sort it

Chain/Belt

Check tension and condition

No one wants that "clunk clunk" soundtrack on a nice ride

Clean It Like You Actually Care

There's something about a clean bike that just rides better. It doesn't, scientifically but it feels like it does, and that's enough.

Get the winter grime off properly

Polish the chrome if that's your thing

While cleaning, you'll spot issues you'd otherwise miss

Bonus: turning up to the first group ride on a gleaming bike earns quiet respect. Turning up filthy earns... comments.

Gear Check – Not Just for Show

We all love the look, but gear's there to keep your skin attached to your body.

Helmet

Any drops, cracks, or “I’ve had this since 2008”?
Replace it

Visor clean? You’ll want to see where you’re going

Jacket & Gloves

Check stitching, armour, and general wear

Waterproofs: test them now, not mid downpour
somewhere near Aviemore

Boots

Grip, comfort, and not falling apart

Wet feet 30 minutes into a ride is a mood killer

Scottish Spring Reality Check

Let’s not kid ourselves it’s still Scotland.

One minute: sunshine and optimism

Next minute: sideways rain and regret

Pack for all of it:

Waterproof layer (non negotiable)

Spare gloves if you’ve got them

Something warm, even if it looks decent when you
leave

Optimism is not a weather strategy.

What’s New in the Garage?

This is the part where we show off a bit.

Got:

A new bike?

A questionable modification?

Something loud, shiny, or completely unnecessary?

Send it in. We’ll feature a few each issue because
half the fun of riding is pretending we needed that
upgrade.

Final Word

A quick check now saves a long wait later usually in
the cold, explaining to your mates why you
“definitely checked everything.”

Get the bike sorted. Get the gear ready. And when
the ride comes... just enjoy it.

Because after a long winter, that first proper run?

That’s what it’s all about.

New for 2026, to support the loss of the ABC's of Touring riding challenge, we are introducing the **RIDE365 Dealer Challenge!**

This is a riding challenge that incorporates the fundamentals of RIDE365:

1. *Riding & logging miles*
2. *Visiting dealerships*
3. *Healthy competition!*

Each UK & Ireland (UKI) based dealership will have a RIDE365 Challenge Sign, these signs can be moved inside & outside the dealership and moved next to your Harley-Davidson to snap a photo. The aim is to visit as many UKI dealerships as possible in the same calendar year, and the take a photo with the RIDE365 Challenge Sign!

Each valid photo, taken at each individual dealership is worth points:

Photo of the RIDE365 Challenge Sign + yourself = 1 point

Photo of the RIDE365 Challenge Sign + yourself + your Harley-Davidson = 2 points

Each dealership RIDE365 Challenge Sign can only be submitted once. With a total of 17 dealerships in the UK & Ireland there is a maximum of 34 Dealership points available.

Certain Harley-Davidson UK & Ireland events will also be locations that HOG members can gain points towards the RIDE365 Dealer Challenge. There is a Harley-Davidson UK & Ireland Event RIDE365 Challenge Sign that will be present at the following events only:

Due to motorcycle access constraints, the following events will only have the ability to gain 1 point (HOG member + RIDE365 Challenge Sign): MotoGP Silverstone & Motorcycle Live – NEC.

Therefore, there is a total of **50 points available for the 2026 calendar year.**

The challenge will have 3 layers:

1. **RIDER:** Individual HOG members holding a valid Full or Life HOG membership can take part with their Harley-Davidson motorcycle(s).
2. **PILLION:** Individual HOG members holding a valid Associate or Life Associate HOG membership can take part as a passenger on a Harley-Davidson motorcycle(s).
3. **CHAPTER:** UK & Ireland Chapters will have the total points of participating members collated.

We are currently developing a dedicated submission webpage - more details on how to submit your photos will follow, but I wanted to take the opportunity to tell you & your members about the challenge before the Open House events taking place at dealerships this weekend!

I have attached a handy checklist to help members track their photos and points. Please encourage your members to snap a photo this weekend with the sign (and their bike!) and we will release details of submission next week, as well as some official terms & conditions.

This challenge is only open to UK & Ireland based HOG members with a valid GB or IE HOG member number, and is only applicable to UK & Ireland based dealerships.
